

Filling aid for the purchase agreement for the pre-financing of insolvency money

In this section, we would like to give you a little help on how to fill out the purchase agreements and the privacy statement using an example.

Purchase agreement

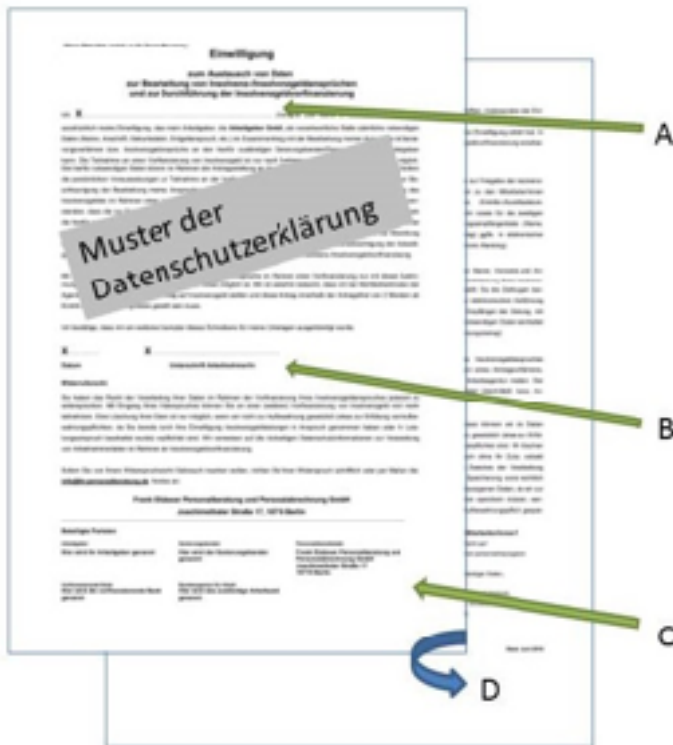
